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ST. PETERSBURG

St. Petersburg is quite young of a little more than three hundred years old, but it has long been included in the list of cities “must to visit”.

Time for visits to St. Petersburg is divided into two periods: White Days (from the end of April to early October) and White nights (October – April).

Tourists come to St. Petersburg in the summer most massively. The peak time is on mid-June. The sun is hiding behind the horizon for a couple of hours and it is normally a pleasant period.

From April to October lasts navigation along the Neva river and bridges are opening every night for passage of large vessels. First bridge opens around 1.30a.m. and all bridges boil down about 5 a.m. Every the bridge in the center is illuminated and open one by other, so, you will enjoy of the show several times from the embankment or from the water, in a comfortable ship. Sightseeing boats in summer go almost around the clock.

During the White Nights, guests are also invited to see another Northern miracle, the Lower Park of fountains in Peterhof. It also starts working from the end of April and close for winter in the middle of October.

Advantages of a trip to St. Petersburg during White Days is a great opportunity to visit museums without crowds of tourists around you. Various exhibitions, theatres and concert halls invite to different concerts, much more than in summer. And most importantly reason of the low season is hotels accommodation at pleasant and affordable prices.

Good news for travelers to Saint Petersburg from the Schengen area is Free Electronic Visa. It starts working from the 1st on October, 2019. Visa applications must be submitted no later than four days prior to the beginning of one’s trip. The electronic visa will be valid for a period of 30 calendar days, however visitors will only be allowed to remain in Russia for up to eight days

MOSCOW



Moscow is the capital of Russia, its political, economic and cultural center. Its population counts more than 12 million residents within the city limits and over 16 million people within the urban area.

It's a giant metropolis where life doesn't stop for a minute. So you can safely go outside late at night and walk to a cafe or bar.

There are many different hotels in Moscow, and on weekends the cost is cheaper than on weekdays, but this rule does not work during world exhibitions.

There are 5 airports in Moscow which carry out passenger transportation, 3 river ports, 2 river passenger stations and 9 railway stations. Therefore, it is possible to reach the Capital in any way from anywhere in the world.


Muscovites move around the city on the metro. Despite the utilitarian importance of this type of transport, most of the stations can be compared with museum objects - they are decorated with mosaics, sculptures, marble, arches. Therefore do not forget to include in the program excursion on a subway.

With a rare exception, during very severe frosts, the Moscow River is navigable all year round, so you can take a trip on a comfortable boat at any time.

"Must Visit" places and excursions in Moscow are:

- Kremlin. It is a complex of majestic structures that took several centuries to build.
- Red Square. The name didn't come about because of the color, but because "red" meant "beautiful" in ancient Russia.
- Next to the area there is zero kilometer. It is a mark signifying the beginning of distance measurements in Russia. It is necessary to make a wish here
- GUM (State Universal Store), the largest shopping mall in the former Soviet Union. It situated near Red Square. For this store make a special ice cream. You will not eat it anywhere else
- Pedestrian street Old Arbat. If you weren't on Old Arbat, you weren't in Moscow!
- Vorobyovy Gory and observation deck. From this place you can see skyscrapers "Moscow-City", Stalin's high-rise buildings (twin houses), TV tower, embankments of the Moskva River, towers of the Kremlin and a huge monument of Peter the Great - one of the highest monuments in the world!
- The Museum Art Park. This is the only real open-air sculpture museum in Russia. Here are about 700 sculptures.
- "Evening lights in Moscow" – excursion by bus: truthfully and legends about underground bunkers and Stalin's high-rises, as well as the stunningly beautiful panoramas of the city.



GOLDEN RING



Tours around province is a great opportunity to enjoy the quiet life in the heart of the Russia. These towns formed of the Russian Orthodox Church and preserve the history of Russia with unique monuments of Russian architecture of the 12th–18th centuries

Traditionally Golden Ring Tours start from Moscow. All towns close to each other, and the circular Golden Ring route makes it possible to easily pass from one place to another. For the trip and moving among the sights it is possible to take a bus or a car trip or go by train to some towns.

There are no luxury hotels on the Golden Ring route, the best you can expect is 4* hotels in Yaroslavl. In some small towns you can only find a Soviet-style hotel.

Also, can taste traditional Russian food, but in some cities there are Western brand fast-food outlets.

VLADIMIR founded in 995, in the 12th century used to be the capital of Russia and its political, cultural and religious center. It is located 179 km from Moscow.

SUZDAL. A calm ancient town at 38 km north to Vladimir is referred to as an open-air museum with old buildings that have been preserved. Here you can enjoy of beautiful views, old monasteries and churches. Several sights fixed by UNESCO. Highlights include the Spaso-Yefimiev Monastery.

IVANOVO. It is located between Suzdal (70 km) and Kostroma. It is both the youngest and the most industrial of all Golden Ring cities by textile trade.

KOSTROMA. A surprisingly calm and inviting town, located on Volga river, 120 km north to Ivanovo. The city is most famous for its Ipatievsky Monastery which has links with the Romanov Dynasty as the first Romanov tsar – Tsar Michael – was here when he was made a tsar.

YAROSLAVL has got its name from the Prince Yaroslav the Wise, who founded the town in the beginning of 11th century. Now it is a large industrial city, the biggest along the Golden Ring and considered the unofficial capital of the Golden Ring, it is also a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The city's main attractions are the Spaso-Preobrazhensky Monastery, St. Elijah the Prophet's and the John the Baptist's Churches, both of which are beautifully decorated with frescos.

ROSTOV VELIKIY or Rostov the Great, named so to distinguish it from the larger Rostov-on-Don. Its history started 4 thousand years B.C. Its most impressive sight is the white-stone kremlin which stands on Lake Nero and is now a museum-reserve. The city also has three monasteries and museums dedicated to the art of painting on enamel for which the city is famed.

PERESLAVL-ZALESSKIY famous for its monasteries, four of which are still active. This place is the birthplace of a celebrated Russian hero – prince Alexander Nevsky, proclaimed saint. Pereslavl-Zalesskiy also links with Peter the Great, who built his first toy flotilla here on Lake Pleshevo.

SERGIEV POSAD is the main attraction is the UNESCO-protected. Troitse-Sergieva Lavra – a monastery founded in the 14th century by St. Sergius of Radonezh, which is one of the most revered Russian saints. At present the Lavra is one of the most important religious sites in Russia



NORTHERN LIGHTS



Northern lights is a dance of thousand lights in the sky on dark night. Lights come in all shapes and colors: blue, yellow, red, green. For a second, the dark sky turns into bright colors and becomes visible around for many kilometers as if by day.

WHEN YOU CAN SEE: from the end of September up until the end of March, and it usually appears from 9 p.m. to midnight. The evening should be frosty and the sky without clouds.

Northern lights is a natural phenomenon, and in spite of forecasts, no one can guarantee its presence and brightness. Therefore, to see the Northern Lights it is better to come to Murmansk for at least 3 days. In the East, believe that one will see the Northern Lights will live happily ever after for the rest of my life!

Aurora hunting tour in Murmansk Suggestions of the itineraries from 1 to 7 days (days and excursions could be changed on your request)

1 day Murmansk

Arrival in Murmansk. Murmansk is called the Russian capital of the Northern Lights, where you can see it 7 months a year
Sightseeing tour of Murmansk (4 h: highest memorial monument behind the Polar circle, the first-ever nuclear power icebreaker and etc.)
Dinner at the hotel.

In the evening we will go hunting for the Northern Lights about 9 p.m. - 01 a.m. You will go to some place in the Murmansk region to find a clear sky. Be ready to go for 100-150 kilometers from Murmansk.

2 day Tour to the Arctic Ocean coast, Teriberka village

(120 km from Murmansk, duration of the tour is 9-10 h)
You will see tundra (northern deserts), Cemetery of old fish boats, Arctic Ocean. Snowmobile sledging trip to the Arctic Ocean coast with big rocks.
Come back to Murmansk.

3 day Tour to Khibiny Mountains, Kirovsk city

(230 km from Murmansk, duration tour 10-11 h)
Visiting the top of the mountain (890 meters) by ski elevator, the 'Snow Village' (town made of snow) and the 'Magic Forest' with snow sculptures. Come back to Murmansk.

4 day Tour to the Sami village with reindeer (4-5 h)

Sami (or Lapi) are indigenous people of Northern Europe.
In the program: Sami dances and rituals, Sami house with reindeer skins, small farm to feed reindeer, snowmobile sledging trip to the forest, souvenir shop. Come back to Murmansk.

5 day Tour to husky park in Lovozero

(170 km from Murmansk, duration tour 10-11 h)
Feeding reindeers, reindeers sledging, You will get dog sledging with real Siberian Huskies (1000 meters), lunch with salmon fish and reindeer meat. Come back to Murmansk.

6 day. Husky sledging in tundra (4 h)

Welcome to Husky sledging trip for distance 400-500 meters for each person.

7 day. Departure from Murmansk

!Take warm clothes in winter: warm winter jacket, winter waterproof pants, thermal underwear, gloves, scarf, hat and high winter boots.

Tour program (for example) to Baikal

1 day arrival to Irkutsk

2 day

A trip to Lake Baikal, in the tourist village of Listvyanka on the lake; Sightseeing tour, a walk along the shore of Lake Baikal; Souvenir market; Fish market; Excursion to the Taltsy Museum - This is a recreated Siberian village

3 day

Departure to the pier "Rocket";

Travel by boat along the Circum-Baikal Railway. An amazingly beautiful monument of engineering at the beginning of the 20th century. It is called the "Golden buckle of the steel belt of Russia." Interesting is the shore of Lake Baikal and the taiga approaching the lake, rock structures resembling medieval castles in which tunnels are broken. During the journey, a stop is provided, time for a walk, the opportunity to take pictures on the background of Lake Baikal.

4 day

Departure from the hotel to Lake Baikal (by bus, travel time about 5-6 hours).

Departure to the island of Olkhon - the largest island on Lake Baikal. Even in its form, it resembles the outlines of Lake Baikal. Olkhon is located in the national park and is considered one of the most beautiful places in Lake Baikal.

Ferry crossing to Olkhon island, travel to the island's capital - Khuzhir village.

5 day

Breakfast.

Sightseeing tour of Khuzhir. Excursion to the sacred "Cape Burhan" (Shaman Rock), this is one of the nine shrines of Asia. There is a through cave in the rock. According to legend, the spirit of the owner of the island lives in this cave. Having visited this place, you will be charged with Baikal energy for a long time.

6 day

Breakfast

Travel by UAZ to the northernmost point of the island - Cape Khoboy.

A place of extraordinary energy and beauty. The beautiful high rock at Cape Khoboy, looks like a sharp fang, resembles the profile of a female head. During the tour, you can see the stunning natural difference between the rocky eastern shore and the flatter west. In fine weather, from Cape Khoboy a view of the widest place of Lake Baikal (80 km) opens.

7 day

Excursions by boat: to the island of Ogoi, to the Buddhist Stupa or to the islands of the Small Sea;

Return to Irkutsk at the evening

Trans-Siberian Railway Tours

If you have some time available and you would like to experience an extraordinary journey crossing the whole Russia, you can take a tour by usual train along the Trans-Siberian Railway.

You can choose 2 options for travel.

The first is by branded train "Russia". The train has number 001 and departs from Vladivostok to Yaroslavl station in Moscow all year-round scheduled departures through the day more than 50 years, since 1966!

The train in the opposite direction has number 002 and passes the same route through major cities of Russia: Vladimir, Nizhny Novgorod, Kirov, Perm, Yekaterinburg, Tyumen, Omsk, Novosibirsk, Krasnoyarsk, Irkutsk, Ulan-Ude, Chita, Belogorsk and Khabarovsk.

During the route the train makes 63 stops. There are 87 cities in total lying the way.

The length of its entire route is 9,259 km and crosses two continents, Europe and Asia and 8 time zones. Also, the train crosses 16 major rivers. Among them is the largest river in Europe — the Volga, and rivers, which are among the ten largest rivers in the world: the Ob with its tributary Irtysh, Yenisei.

The train for more than 207 km runs along the deepest lake in the world — lake Baikal, which contains one fifth of the fresh water on the planet.

If you choose this way to travel it takes 6 days to get to the final station directly. Stops according to the schedule last for 2-45 minutes depending on the city.

Doors in the compartment of the train "Russia" are equipped with electronic locks. Here is a shower, but in a separate car.

The train has compartments for disabilities persons and special space for kids with toys and books.

The second way is a trip on the same route, but with access and stops at hotels in the most important cities at your request. During the stops we can offer a sightseeing tour in the desired language (English, Spanish, Portuguese, French, Italian, German or Chinese speaking guides, etc).

Of course, this option will be longer if you follow the entire route.

Yekaterinburg is a "Capital of the Ural Mountains". The city was founded in 1723 by Tsar Peter I as the center of metallurgical industry. By the 20th century it had become one of the largest and the most important financial, industrial and cultural centers of Russia.

Novosibirsk is the third largest city and the biggest of Siberia. It was founded in 1893 as the future site of the Trans-Siberian railway bridge crossing the Siberian River Ob. Despite some distance from the Central part of Russia, there are well-equipped medical centers and research institutes. Around the city grows a real Siberian forest" Taiga. You can go there by excursion.

Krasnoyarsk used to be a "closed city" during Soviet times – closed to foreigners and also to most Soviet citizens at that time. It is located along the Yenisei River. A sightseeing tour shows you several view points and the main shopping street which is fascinating as the local mayor decided to decorate it with palm trees in summer time – in the middle of Siberia!

Irkutsk called "Paris of Siberia" because of its colorful life style during the time of the Tsars. You can visit the old town with its large quarters still consisting of wooden houses only, before invited to the cultural highlight of the tour, a private classical concert in a palace of historical background.

Lake Baikal holds the biggest fresh water reserves in the world. It stretches up to 42km from east to west and more than 595km from north to south. If you do the stop for Baikal, you can walk through the village Listvyanka shows you to St Nicholas church, on a great Siberian lunch you can taste the famous Omul fish which lives only in Lake Baikal and a boat takes you on a short cruise to the small village to visit the typical wooden houses of local people.

The best military museums in Moscow

Central Museum of the Great Patriotic War

Including in the building there are several magnificent dioramas: "Blockade of Leningrad", "Kursk Bulge" and "Forcing the Dnieper".

Central Air Force Museum

The museum has a very large area - the real combat helicopters, planes and other air vehicles are presented here.

Central Museum of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation

This military museum, existing since 1919, is the most important in Russia. Here you can see about fifteen thousand samples of armored heavy equipment, aircraft and missile launch facilities.

State Museum of Defense of Moscow

The museum talks about the defense of Moscow from the soldiers of Nazi Germany.

Museum complex "History of the T-34"

In the museum you can not only see, but also get into one of the eight presented T-34 tanks.

Museum of German Anti-Fascists

The museum is located on the territory where the prisoner of war camp previously operated.

Tank Museum "Kubinka"

The museum is the largest of its kind. Here you can see many Russian and German tanks.

The best military museums in St Petersburg

Monument to the heroic defenders of Leningrad

The monument was opened on May 9, 1975, on the 30th anniversary of the Victory. In the center of the huge podium is a 48-meter obelisk.

Museum of the Russian Submarine Forces named after Alexander Marinesko

The museum shows the whole history of the submarine fleet from the time of Peter I to the present day.

Central Naval Museum

The huge museum contains over 700,000 items. These are breadboard models of ships, objects of marine life, instruments, navy uniforms, sea flags and a collection of weapons of the imperial family.

Military Medical Museum

The museum is dedicated to the development of military medical service

Museum of Defense and Siege of Leningrad

The collection of the Museum of Defense and the Siege of Leningrad is dedicated to the immortal feat of the inhabitants of the city on the Neva.

Museum of Artillery, Engineering and Signal Corps

To date, the museum has a rich collection of Russian and foreign weapons, which were brought from 54 countries.

Submarine D-2 "Narodovolets"

The appearance and internal structure of the submarine is fully consistent with the state of the Second World War.

Museum-Diorama "Breakthrough of the blockade of Leningrad"

One of the largest panoramas in the world (600 square meters)
